BILL BECK SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

1. Five \$1000 scholarships will be awarded annually to high school seniors or current college students.
2. Scholarship applications **must** be received in the Association office by March 1st and will be awarded by May 1st of the same year. All applications **must** include a copy of high school transcript and/(if applicable) a copy of recent college transcript.
3. Applications must be children of employees of member dealerships and the employee must have been employed within the same dealership organization for a minimum of three (3) years. Children of officers/directors of member dealerships/organizations are not eligible for scholarship awards.
4. The scholarship will be maintained through five (5) years of college upon annual request as long as:
 - * a "C" average is maintained;
 - * the student is a "full time" student (at least 12 credit hours per semester);
 - * the parents maintain employment within same organization.
5. A scholarship committee consisting of 3 member dealers and the Association director will make the annual awards.
